





.. because there's so much to see, only a few highlights:

#### **#1) FORTRESS MARIENBERG**

It's the town's landmark and houses a museum with a collection of Franconian art. It takes some time to walk up the steep castle hill through the vineyards but once you're there you're rewarded with a fantastic view over the old town! (Lazy people might also just take the bus. The site is open anytime and there is no entrance fee, except for the museum.

#### **#2** ALTE MAINBRÜCKE

The oldest bridge across the river Main and known for its characteristic statues of the Saints. It's a popular meeting point for all those who like to enjoy a glass of Franconian wine and a little chit-chat while watching the swiftly flowing river. The view of the fortress is really nice from there and gets all the more beautiful the darker it gets. Don't miss it!

### **#3** MARIENKAPELLE & FALKENHAUS

The two characteristic buildings on the market square. The Falkenhaus, a former guesthouse, is loved for its ornate stucco facade and nowadays houses the public library. The Marienkapelle, "Mary's Chapel", is a richly ornamented hall church built in the late Gothic period. Famous are the sandstone figures of Adam and Eve by the German sculptor Tilman Riemenschneider above the southern portal. The entrance is free.

## **#4)** LUSAMGÄRTCHEN

This hidden garden is an island of tranquility and a haven for lovers and hopeless romantics. A memorial stone for Walther von der Vogelweide, famous minstrel and Germany's very first popstar, was set up here in 1930. It is said that if you're lovesick and put down some flowers on the stone, your broken heart will be healed immediately. Free entrance from Martinstrasse; open until 5pm every day.

## #5) RESIDENCE PALACE

One of the most important Baroque palaces in Europe and UNESCO world cultural heritage site. It's famous for its grand staircase and huge ceiling painting. After you've taken a tour through the palace, take a break in the lovely court gardens and enjoy the quiet atmosphere there. April — October: (daily) 09:00-18:00, November — March: (daily) 10:00-16:30.

#### **#6** WEINHAUS SCHNABEL

It's one of the oldest restaurants in Würzburg and serves typical Franconian food. If you want to try Bratwurst with Sauerkraut and a glass of local wine in a special atmosphere, you should definitely go here! It's only a three minute walk from the hostel.
