

# **Dear Hostel guests,**

in these unusual times there are certain things you must pay attention to. The legal guidelines and rules are constantly changing. We will update the information as quickly as possible after any new developments.

#### At the moment:

- in public areas of the hostel guests from the 15. birthday must wear a FFP 2 mask, up to 15. birthday a mouth-nose covering
- valid contact restrictions must be observed
- guests who do not belong to the same household in relation to each other may not be accommodated together in one room or accommodation unit
- the distance rule of 1.5 m must be observed

#### Required for arrival:

- Proof of recovery by official PCR or PoC-PCR test, at least 28 days and maximum 6 months ago
- or PCR or POC antigen test not older than 24 hours (prerequisite is that overnight guests have proof of testing upon arrival and every additional 48 hours)
- or vaccination certificate with entry of the complete vaccination against COVID 19; at least 14 days must have passed since the second vaccination; protective vaccination with one or more vaccines named by the Paul-Ehrlich-Institut has taken place
- in German, English, French, Italian or Spanish in tangible or digital form
- the testing obligation applies only to purely tourist overnight stays

# Not allowed to stay overnight or enter the hostel:

- Persons who have had contact with COVID-19 cases in the past 14 days, or have a confirmed SARS-CoV2 infection
- or are subject to quarantine measures for other reasons
- or have symptoms associated with COVID-19.

If you develop symptoms during your stay, you must leave immediately and not enter the common areas. In this case you should inform the reception by phone or email. If you wish we can arrange a doctor for you.

#### What works, what doesn't?

- Unfortunately, we cannot offer our daily socializing program at the moment, but we are working on alternatives.
- The guest kitchen is open, rules about distance and contact restrictions are to be followed.
- We have developed a hygiene concept for overnight stays in shared rooms, in accordance with the current conditions.
- Arrivals are subject to the current coronavirus entry regulations of the German government. You can find out about the current number of cases in Europe and Germany on the website of the Robert Koch Institute.
